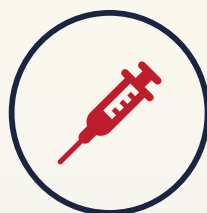

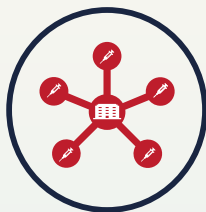

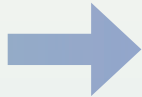
# India's Immunization Coverage 2023-24\*

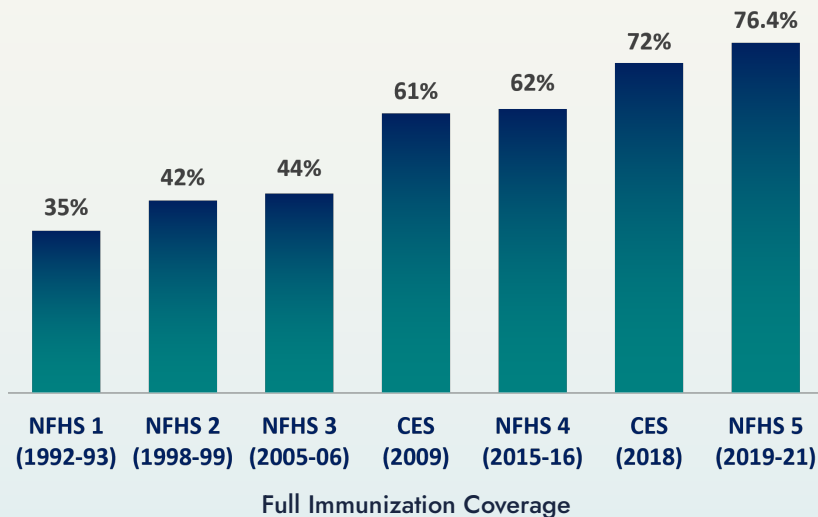

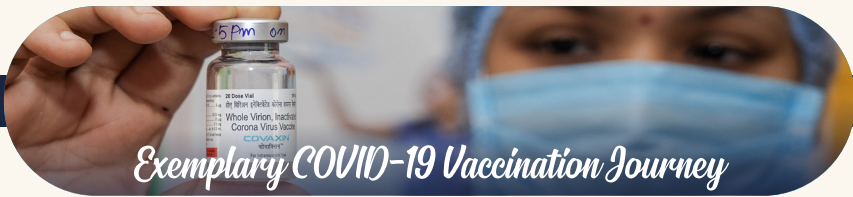

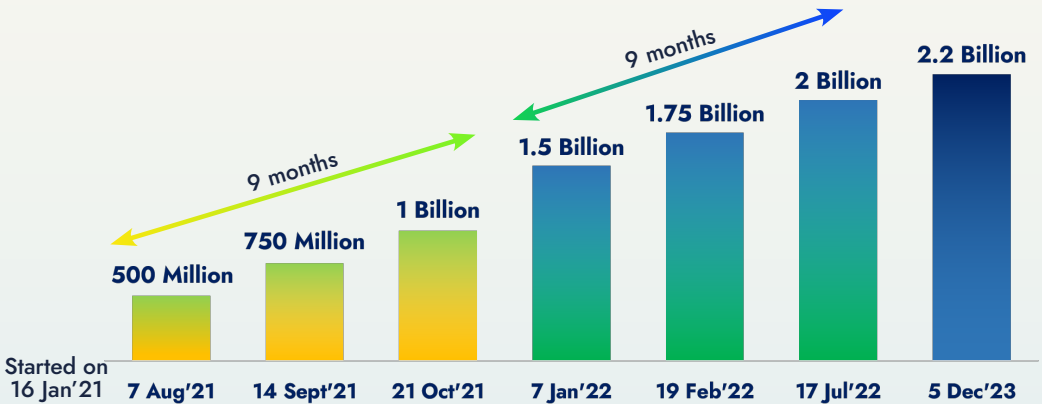
